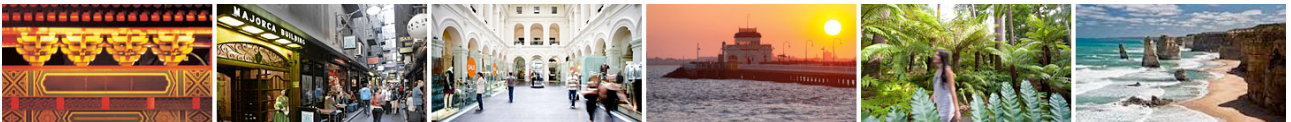
4th Asia Oceania Meteorological Satellite Users Conference – First Announcement
